Cllr Forbes said that the recommendation from the Village Council has been sent to Mid Sussex District Council (MSDC) but that in a proposal of this size, the application will go to the MSDC Planning Committee rather than being decided by an individual officer. The response for small applications are usually 8 weeks, but for a development such as this, MSDC usually have a target response time of 13 weeks.
